

TIPS FOR BOOKING DAYCARE:

- Book in advance & adjust dates later (but don't forget your days!! We can always send you a new list of reserved days, just ask!)
- Want multiple days? Save your self the form-filling-out time, just send an email: info@camphappyhound.com!
- Tuesday & Friday (any day) regular? Book every
 "Tuesday & Friday" for multiple weeks/all of your
 package days; adjust later if needed! (send an email!)
- Don't always rely on your confirmation emails for remaining package days. Days are not taken from your account until check OUT.. ie. If you book 5 days at a time, your confirmation's total days will remain the same! We can always update you! & We do our best to let you know when you get down to your last few.

LOOK FOR AND CHECK EVERY CONFIRMATION EMAIL! If your confirmation email shows the wrong date, you must let us know; reply to said confirmation email or call Camp.

Confirmation emails are sent to the email address registered with your pup on their Evaluation Day.

Cancellations/Rescheduling is permitted until 5pm the previous day. Changes made after 5pm the previous day (or day of said reservation), will result in the loss of said pre-paid/package day. Exceptions based on reasoning.

Any **OUT-OF-DATE SHOTS** will show in your confirmation emails (if none show, your pet is UTD). If your pet has a shot out, we MUST have proof of vaccination BEFORE we can accept your pup for daycare.

Venmo payments MUST BE MADE BY 2:00PM. Payments made after 2pm do not process in our system in time for the afternoon.

Payments made after 2pm do not process in our system in time for the afternoon checkout, which makes for a difficult pick up.

 If you can't remove the foreign object, using the heel of your hand, deliver 4-5 sharp blows on the dog between the shoulder blades.



# Homemade Dog Treats \*DIABETIC\* DOG

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- ½ cup whole wheat flour
- 2 eggs
- 1 ½ pounds beef liver (cut into piece)

### **COOKING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350degrees F. Line a 10x15 inch jellyroll pan with parchment paper.
- 2. Place liver into a food processor. Pulse until finely chopped. Stir in flour and eggs using wooden spoon. Spread evenly in the pan.
- 3. Bake for 15 minutes, or until center is firm. Cool, and cut into squares. Store in fridge. **Yields 36.**

### **WOUND CARE**


